Child Tax Credit

These are often:

- Self-employed
- Families with a child under 12 months old
- Middle and higher income families
- Families with a disabled child
- Students
- Single Parents

If you have a baby under 12 months old you may even get Child Tax Credit with an income of around £66,000 gross. (Pension contribution payments are deducted from the figure used for your income. Child maintenance payments are ignored). Working Tax Credit may be payable too if you are working but on a lower income.
