Limited Capability for Work (ESA and UC)

This course focuses on the limited capability of work assessment for contribution-based Employment and Support Allowance and Universal Credit. The course will give you an in-depth understanding of the assessment for people whose health or disability limits their ability to work. It promotes stronger claims and challenges by offering a thorough understanding of the grounds for decisions and an awareness of common problems.

Over the day we will consider:

- Who can get contributory Employment and Support Allowance
- The Work Capability Assessment
- Universal Credit and limited capability for work
- An introduction to conditionality and work-related activity
- Moving from Employment and Support Allowance to Universal Credit

This course is relevant to anyone who works with claimants of working age who may need support with understanding and managing the capability for work assessment process.

By the end of the course you will have:

Confidence to advise clients who cannot work due to ill health. Be able to support clients through the Work Capability Assessment and know when to claim Employment and Support Allowance and/or Universal Credit.
