Benefits for Disabled Young People Including Students 2 online modules

This course will look in detail at what happens to parent claims as young people approach key ages (such as 16, 19 or 20) or leave education. Benefits available to disabled young people are also covered, including how disabled students can claim Universal Credit while in education. Case studies and calculations will be used to highlight entitlement and support learning.

Module one will consider:

- Personal Independence Payment
- Benefits for 16 and 17 year olds
- Young people who are not in education
- Who is a qualifying young person?
- Transition from parent claim to young person claiming: choices available

Module two will consider:

- What is full-time study?
- Establishing limited capability for work
- Claiming Universal Credit
- Treatment of student income for Universal Credit
- Common problems and how to overcome them

This course is suitable for advisers who work with disabled young people or the parents of disabled young people. Participants should have knowledge of the benefits system.
